Your check will be cashed if your bid is approved. If a bid is not approved, it will be returned to you. Bids will be opened and reviewed by the

District Council Executive Committee on July 7. Winning bidders being notified shortly thereafter. Bids may be given to any District Council member, or to the bar tender in the Rathskeller this weekend or next. Here are the cottages up for bid.
