- Cottage Available cottage #49 is available for a bid of \$500 or best offer. It is a one and a half room cottage with a basement that is located behind the Rathskeller. Sealed bids are due by August 22, and will be opened at the District Council meeting that evening. Bidders must be a member in good standing of one of the Illinois District societies for a minimum of year. The winning bidder will be responsible for the 2016 ground lease payment that will be issued at the end of September and due November 1, 2016. Bidders do not have to be present at the District meeting. Bids should clearly identify who the bidder is (name, address, etc.), what Society they belong to, and how long they have been a member. Bids should include a check for the full bid amount and will only be cashed if your bid is accepted. Bids not accepted will be returned uncashed.
- Bathrooms this is a crappy subject but needs to be discussed. Many cottages have added small (and not so small) chemical toilets. Of course they need to be periodically emptied. We have started to see two problems with the emptying of of the chem-johns into our bathrooms. First, sometimes there is so much solid waste (I said this was a crappy subject.... J) dumped in, that the toilet clogs when flushed. Second, when dumped the waste sprays all over the toilet, floor, and walls causing a real mess and rendering that stall unusable. We are exploring installing a trap door to dump waste directly into one of our septic fields to provide a more direct route to empty waste. However until that is finished, please follow those simple steps.
