**From the History of Eiche Turners**: "During the First World War, 93 percent of the Turners were found fit for active duty, compared to the general population average of 67 percent."

The Illinois District Council adopted a formal policy regarding the assignment of work duties to cottage owners at its June 22, 2019 meeting. In summary, the Council believes that cottage-owner participation in the operations of ITC is an essential aspect of Camp culture. Further, the Council adopted a policy that re-establishes the practice of all cottage owners being assigned three work duties per summer. The Council also adopted the recommendation to reserve the "Pool Admissions" and "Coupon Book" duties for cottage owners 65 years and above who request it. In addition, ITC will develop a "willing-to-sub" list – to be distributed in the Spring mailing (and posted on the ITC website) - allowing a cottage owner the opportunity to contact a fellow Turner to make an alternate arrangements if they are unable to fulfill their assigned duty. Copies of the complete policy are available in the Rathskeller.
