In response to ongoing challenges with people parking at their cottages, the District Council has updated the parking policy to include specific timing and fines. Please see the revised section from the Rules and Regulations (updated 6/25/22) below:

Parking near cottages is prohibited. Cottage owners are permitted to load or unload from their vehicles from service roads only for no more than 15 minutes, but <u>ALL</u> vehicles <u>MUST</u> be parked in a designated parking lot as indicated on the Camp map except for the Building and Grounds Committee Chairperson during active work hours and ongoing Camp projects. On an annual basis, parking violators will receive a verbal warning for the first infraction, a written warning for the second infraction, a \$100 fine for the third infraction, and a \$200 fine per infraction thereafter. Continued violation of the parking policy may be subject to additional action by the Camp Committee and/or the Illinois District Council. Thank you, Cory Litza Cottage Owners Presidents
